

06.08.2020 – Minutes of The Monthly Meeting convened by the Principal, attended by all teaching staff.

Held on 6TH AUGUST 2020

Attended by: all teaching staff

The Principal convened the meeting, started with a silent prayer for the wellbeing of everyone and discussed the following points:

- Thanked the **benevolent management** for paying full salary for the month of July despite financial constraints due to lockdown
- Every month management will review fund position to decide on the payment of salary
- Thanked sincerely the teachers conducting online classes from March
- This resulted in a **positive response** from parents and 50% of them have paid the fees
- On the request of some parents, arrangements have been made to collect the fees in 3 instalments instead of 2
- Vide 27th July circular the Management Committee has conveyed the following decisions as a temporary measure:
 - 1. EL encashment of 2019-20 has been put on hold, as guided by the government, for one year. Retirees would be given full benefit
 - 2. Enhancement of DA is suspended till July 2021
 - 3. Annual increment is put on hold until normalcy returns
- **The Secretary & Correspondent** had expressed his keenness to attend some of the online classes as an observer and accordingly links would be shared with him
- **Educational Webinar** by The Ultimate Knowledge on "TUK Assessment" would be conducted on 10th August, details of which would be sent to all the staff
- Elaborate arrangements have been made for a pooja at the temple next door.
- Awaiting guidelines from the government regarding Independence Day celebrations in the school.

07.08.2020 – All the teaching staff, except PETs, Art & Craft, Music teachers, were asked to attend the webinar by 'The Ultimate Knowledge' on 'TUK Assessment' on 10th August at 7pm.

- The Principal shared the message which he received from the DEO regarding Std X result and temporary mark list.



- The Principal shared the request from Times NIE with teachers to send the names of the students who had made some innovative projects that could contribute to our country's "Atma Nirbhar" - Self-Dependent vision.
- The salient features of the **ORIENTATION MEETING** conducted by the Principal for the **parents of Std XI students:**

Attended by about 50 parents and staff of Hr. Sec.

- The Principal welcomed the parents of the new admissions to the Std XI.
- The meeting started with a 1-minute silence as a prayer for the well being of everyone in the Covid 19 context.
- The Principal apologized that this Orientation Meeting could not be held on 22nd July, as planned earlier, due to (a) that some of the parents could not even collect the admission forms due to the lockdown and (b) the publication of std X results did not take place as expected, which is now expected on 10th August.
- He urged the parents who have duly paid the fees, to collect all the books at the school at the earliest as the Online-classes are scheduled to start on Thursday the 13th at the earliest
- He appealed to the parents who are yet to pay the fees to hurry to complete the process to enable their wards to attend the classes without missing..
- He conveyed to the parents that the school was satisfied with the functioning of the Zoom App for online classes.
- He assured the parents that the Time Table has been drawn to avoid overlapping of classes so that two children in the same family would be able to attend their classes without requiring an additional device.

- He stressed that at least one of the parents should **regularly monitor** their children while attending the online class as (a) they can easily leave the online room without detection (b) they can be easily distracted by the destructive information/material available online and go astray.
- He also appealed to them to provide a congenial atmosphere at home for the children to attend the classes by ensuring others at home do not distract them by watching tv or entertaining visitors etc.
- He also advised the students to relieve themselves of the physical strain by walking around the house for a few minutes during the gap between classes (which are so designed) and also provide relief to their eyes from stress.
- He made an important announcement that the internal marks of 10 in each subject is for regular attendance, among other aspects, and that their wards should not miss any class to score that.
- He emphasized that the lessons covered online will not be repeated when the schools physically reopen, presumably by 1st September and hence the parents should ensure their children did not miss any class.
- The parents should take the Std XI seriously as it will not be an automatic pass as earlier and that it be mentioned in the Higher Secondary mark sheet along with the Std XII marks. This practice, as in degree certificates, has been introduced effective the current year. As such, it would have bearing on their qualification for higher education and employment.

The meeting concluded with the Principal wishing the children a happy schooling and the parents thanking him for the orientation program.

- The Principal and the AHM conducted a Parent - Teacher meeting at 7 pm for the parents of Std III &IV regarding online classes. 50 parents attended the meeting.







14.08.2020 – Independence Day invitation was shared in the group. All the teachers were invited for the function.

15.08.2020 – Independence Day was celebrated in our school premises and the photos have been shared in the WhatsApp group.



The 74th Independence Day celebration started at 7.50 a.m and ended at 8.40 a.m adhering to the guidelines given by Government with restricted number of staff participants.

The program started with the invocation of Tamil Thai Vazhthu followed by the flag hoisting by the AHM.
